Two paths remain—both by design.

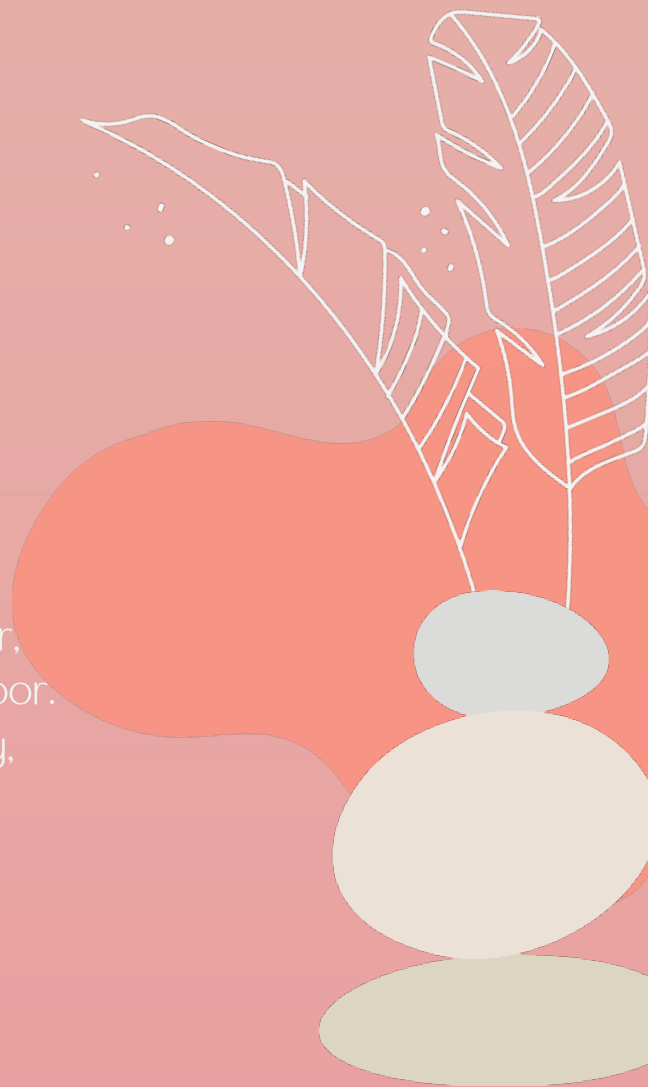
[Verse 9]

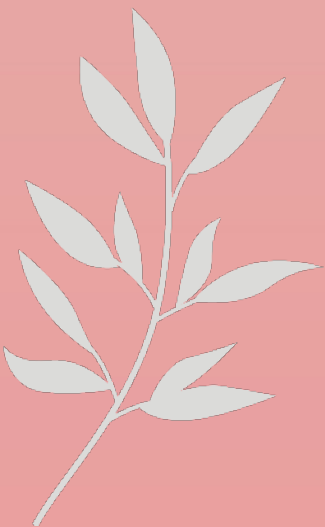
# FOR CONSIDERATION

Matthew 7:13-14

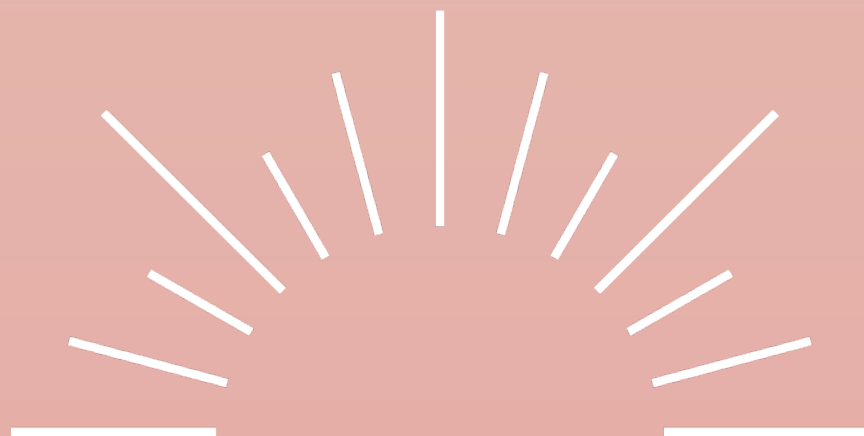
