Reflection

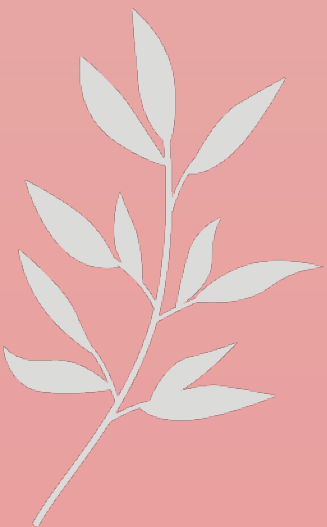
